Whereas, Terrence Horton is being honored for petitioning then Congressmen Elliot Engel, to include and recognize Corporal Morris D. Link, and the Harlem Hellfighters, into the Congressional Record in 2018; and

Whereas, Terrence Horton was part of the effort to memorialize the 369th Harlem Hellfighters Infantry Regiment in Arlington National Cemetery in September 2025; and

Whereas, as former Commissioner of Public Works for the City of Mt. Vernon, Terrence Horton was instrumental in reducing the overtime budget by half a million dollars, increasing the quality of services for the citizens of Mount Vernon revitalizing of all entrances to the city of Mount Vernon, and creating the "Warrior's Way" in Brush Park; and

Whereas, Terrence Horton holds the Title of Deputy Commissioner of Mount Vernon Auxiliary Police, ret. functioning in several capacities which directly involved the Veterans Department; and

Whereas, Terrence Horton is CEO and President of Sentinel Development & Construction, Inc., Sentinel Technology Services International Inc., and Sentinel Electric Inc.; and

Whereas, Terrence Horton is directly responsible for the development and relationship building that brought about the Sister City agreement established April 15th, 2014, between the two great cities of Gwangju South Korea and Mount Vernon.

Now therefore, be it resolved that Terrence Horton be honored on behalf of the United States House of Representatives and the constituents of the 16th Congressional District of the State of New York on this day, the 15th of September 2025, for his leadership in community development and veteran recognition.
